

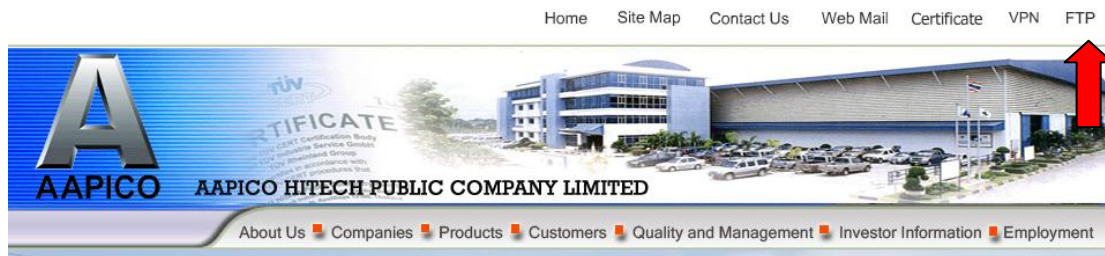


# FTP Service Manual

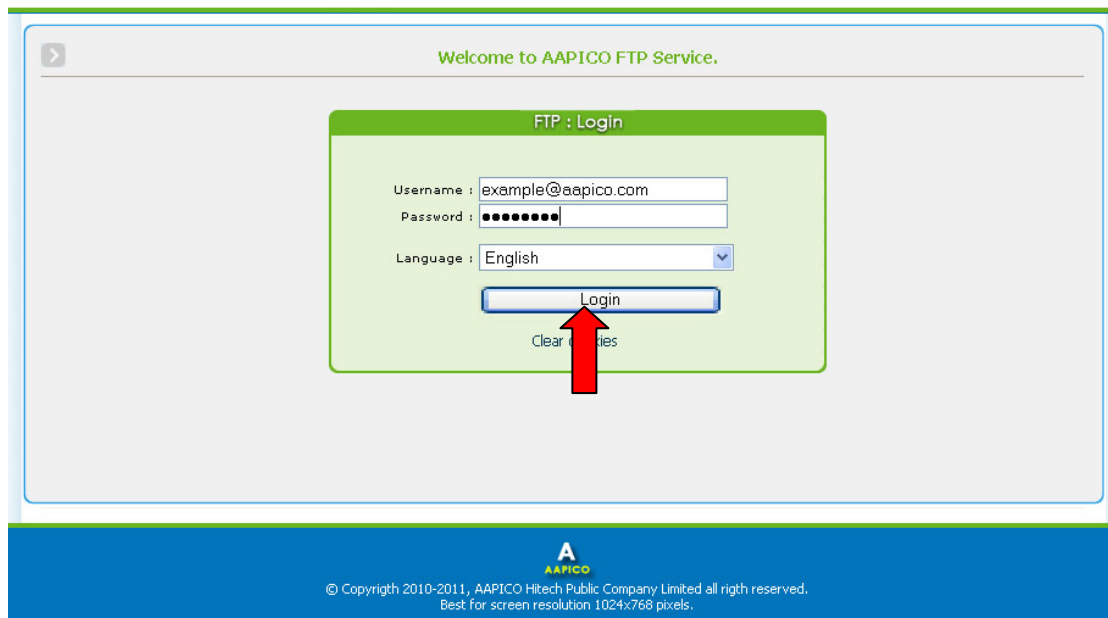
1. Open Internet Explorer
